Rotational and **Stockpiled Pasture Systems**













Stockpile Grazing

Cost Per Cow 25 – 50 Cents Per Day

\$2.50 per day to feed stored bales

Picture is of remaining pasture after bale grazing

30 Paddocks allow rotational grazing









Same Field

Not Bale Grazed

Bale ____ grazed













Early growth of forage cut in June

Allows later season pasture growth



Reseeding Forages, Kura Clover, and grasses



Pasture Rejuvenation

Cows fed in spring Pure Mud

Disked Broadcast Seed Harrowed







Crops planted for later harvest

Sorghum and Sudan grass are planted early June

Grazed in November





Stockpiled grass for late season grazing









Bale Grazing

- Late fall when snow comes
- Spread bales far enough apart
- Manure is spread





Grazing

- Keep fertility levels high
- Have sufficient number of paddocks to allow for long recovery period
- Plant alternative crops to stretch the season
- Monitor, adjust, and be flexible in when and where you rotate
