	Make sure that your research, program or module director knows the name of the international student advisor who will accompany and inform you thoughout the process	
	If there is <b>travel to Quebec</b> :	
		Have drawn up a quarantine plan
		Communicate with the international student advisor to plan your arrival (and inform them of your quarantine plan)
		Send your immigration documents (CAQ and study permit) to the international student advisor on site
		Communicate with a member of UQAT staff related to your study project (your research, program or module director, the technician or the exectutive secretary) to proceed with your registration
		Ensure that UQAT is on the list of <u>institutions authorized to receive</u> <u>international students</u> (list which may be called upon to evolve)
		Use <u>ArriveCan</u> and submit certain information digitally before your arrival, but also after your entry into Canada. <u>Click here to know more</u>
If the studies are done remotely:		
		Send your immigration documents (CAQ and study permit) to the international student advisor by email: <a href="mailto:sae-international@uqat.ca">sae-international@uqat.ca</a>
		Communicate with a member of UQAT staff related to your study project (your research, program or module director, the technician or the exectutive secretary) to register for remote courses
		Communicate with the international student advisor to plan your eventual arrival
		Reflect on and write up your quarantine plan with a view to a potential arrival in the summer or fall of 2021 (by communicating with the international student advisor)
