REGISTRATION METHODS

A- Online registration

PAYMENT METHODS

- > Tuition fees are payable upon registration for all students.
- > Full-time students may pay their tuition fees in two instalments. Check the Academic Calendar for payment deadlines or see ugat.ca/calendrier.

How to pay your tuition fees

A- Credit Card

Pay your fees with a Visa or MasterCard using the ugat.ca/symbiose portal. Click on the «Pay my tuition fees» tab or phone the UQAT Finance Services office at 819 762-0971, ext. 2313, or toll free at 1 877 870-872, ext. 2313.

B- Caisse Desjardins

If you have a bank account with Caisses Desjardins you can pay your tuition fees on their website at www.desjardins.com. Your permanent code serves as your billing number.

You can also pay at the counter at any Caisses Desjardins in Québec, show your bill or UQAT statement of account.

C- Cheque or money order

Late payment fees

A late fee of \$25.00 may be billed to the student's account for payments not received by Finance Services before the date noted in the Academic Calendar.

Returned cheques

When a cheque is returned by the bank, an administrative charge of \$25.00 is levied. In addition, the student risks losing the privilege of paying fees by cheque.

Outstanding accounts

Unless otherwise arranged with Finance Services, students with outstanding accounts will be denied access to registration as long as the outstanding account is not paid.

This restriction also applies to overdue accounts with the Université's services.

Students who do not pay their fees are ineligible to receive their diploma or official attestation of studies from the Université, and will be denied the privilege of registering for courses in person, by mail, or via the internet.

Reimbursement (Refund)

When the Université cancels all the courses in which a student has registered, the student receives a full refund. However, if the student cancels one or more courses according to established procedures and within the required deadlines, some fees will not be refunded. Students who are not residents of Quebec (Undergraduate and Graduate professional streams)

For students who are not residents of Quebec, a fixed fee in the amount of \$119.99 per credit (subject to change) is levied from undergraduate as well as Master's and Ph.D. students.

Non-Canadian students (Undergraduate and Graduate professional streams)

For students who are not Canadian citizens, add a fixed fee amount of \$413.12 or \$469.72 per credit, depending on the program chosen.

Students resident in Quebec (Graduate and Post-Graduate research streams)

For full-time students:

Students must pay \$1033.95 per trimester, plus general and related fees according to the number of credits taken, for the minimum duration (three trimesters for Master's programs and six trimesters for Ph.D. programs). Subsequently, the student must register for research and must pay \$250.00 per trimester plus general and related fees, corresponding to the number of credits taken, until the student has finished their program of study. Registration in summer trimesters is mandatory.

Part-time students:

Students must pay \$516.98 per trimester plus general and related fees according to the number of credits taken for the minimum duration (6 trimesters for Master's programs and 12 trimesters for Ph.D. programs). Subsequently, the student must register for research and must pay \$250.00 per trimester plus related fees, corresponding to the number of credits taken, until the student has finished their program of study. Registration in summer trimesters is mandatory.

Tuition fees for courses external to a student's program and for upgrading courses are paid in addition to the fees already mentioned; they are calculated according to the scale used for undergraduate students.

Students who are not residents of Quebec (Graduate and Post-Graduate research streams)

Students registered in a full-time Master's program (with thesis) must pay \$1799.85 per trimester in differential fees in addition to \$1033.95 in tuition fees for the minimum duration. Part-time students must pay \$899.92 in differential fees (subject to change) as well as \$516.98 in tuition fees per trimester. Registration in summer trimesters is mandatory.

Non-Canadian students (Graduate and Post-Graduate research streams)

For graduate students, added to the \$1033.95 tuition fee is a fixed fee of \$6,196.80 per session, for the minimum duration. For Ph.D. students, the fixed fee is \$5,453.85 per session for the minimum duration. All fees are subject to change.

Additionally, non-Canadian students (exemptions excepted) must subscribe to a Desjardins Health and Hospitalization Insurance Plan at a cost of \$792.00 per year (subject to change). Contact Student Services for more details or see uqat.ca/international.
